We are pleased to share our Annual Water Stewardship Communication for the Financial Year 2025–26. As a stakeholder of the site , we remain committed to transparent reporting and collaborative stewardship. This letter outlines the activities conducted, challenges encountered, and achievements delivered during the year — all made possible through your invaluable support and partnership.

**Activities Conducted During FY 2025–26**

- Conducted 2 WASH awareness sessions across 3 catchment villages on water conservation and hygiene .
- Delivered water literacy programmes in schools — Muppireddypally, Kondapur, Kallakal — and Anganwadi centers
- Conducted 2 training sessions for industries & suppliers on water efficiency and responsible water use practices
- Maintained Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) at plant level through continuous operation of ETP & STP
- Water Coolers supply to Muppireddypally and Rangaiahpally villages against the planned 2 water coolers.
- Sanitary Pad Incinerator Machines to Rangaiah pally and Kallakal Village Schools.
- Dining Facility to Rangaiah pally school
- Toilet & Wash rooms infrastructure facility work to Rangaiah pally school.
- Toys to of Muppireddypally and Kallakal Anganwadi schools
- Covered 10 sessions across 5 non-catchment localities; constructed 400 toilets in Karnataka Leaf Division communities
- Conducted menstrual health education and sanitary pad distribution in partnership with NGOs
- Supplied PPE kits to farmers and conducted awareness sessions on sustainable tobacco cultivation practices
- Implemented water-saving innovations: AHU Eliminator Modification, Smart Water Fixtures, and shift from wet to dry mopping of solar panels.

**Key Challenges Faced**

- Catchment awareness sessions target partially met 1 of 2 due to community scheduling constraints during the crop season
- Sustaining supplier participation in water efficiency training amid operational pressures
- Adhesive cleaning on running taps — uncontrolled water wastage.
- AHU eliminators — continuous, unregulated water loss
- Storage & header tanks — overflow and spillage
- Conventional taps & toilets — excessive usage due to uncontrolled flow

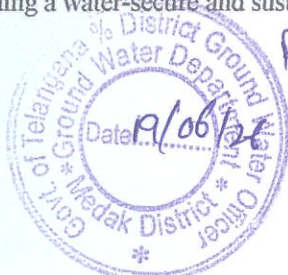

**Targets & Plans for FY 2026–27**

- Reduce specific water consumption to 1.86 KL / Mn Cigarettes; increase water reuse by 5%
- Expand catchment village coverage from 5 to 10 villages through structured community engagement
- Conduct minimum 2 AWS & WASH awareness sessions in each village and with each industry partner
